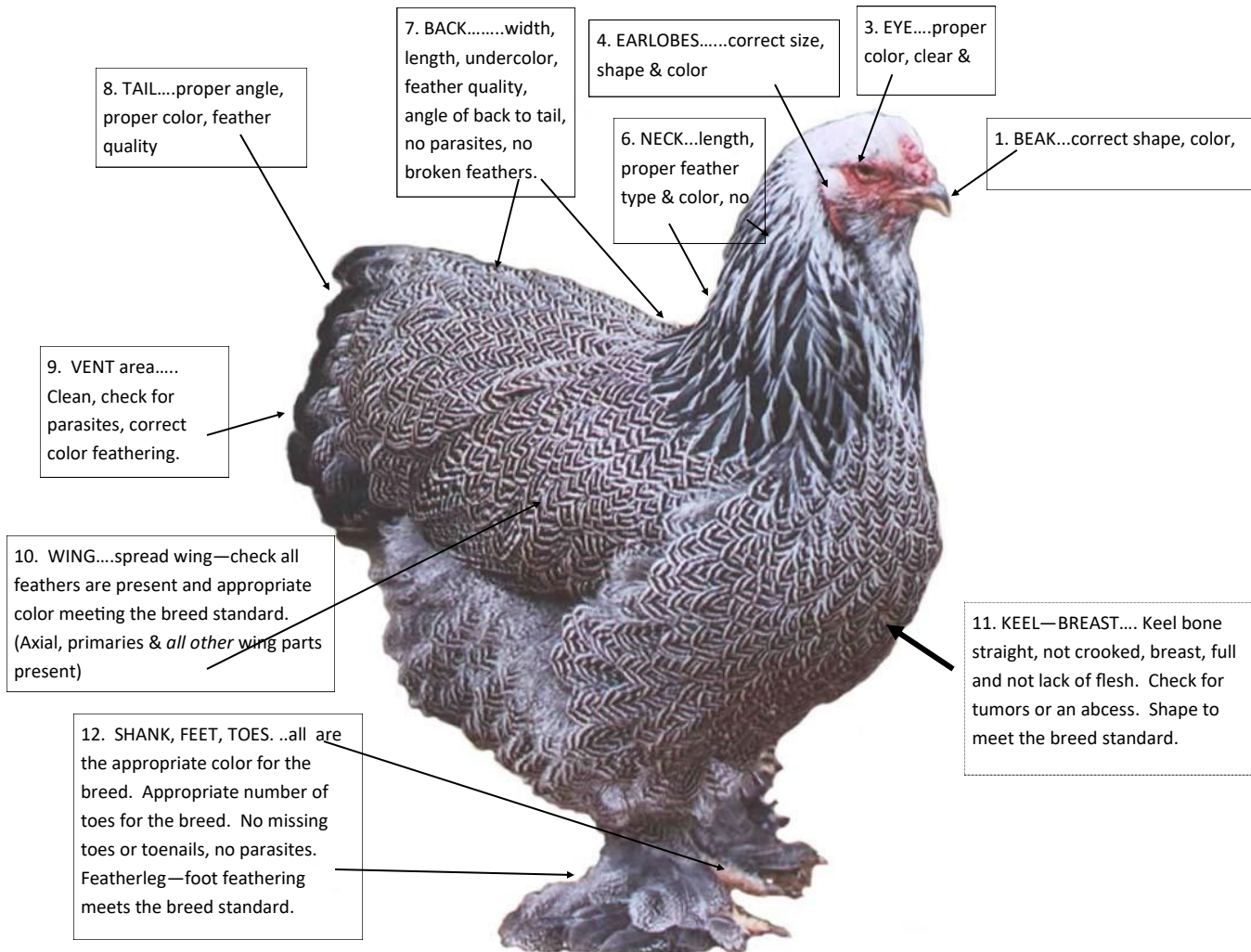

CHOOSING YOUR BIRD (S) TO SHOW For the Beginner

Know the breed "standard" of the bird you are showing be it chicken, duck, goose, turkey, guinea and learn the defects as well as the disqualifications of your breed plus the general defects or disqualifications for any breed.

See what the judge sees!

DOES YOUR BIRD MEET THE BODY TYPE OF THE APA STANDARD??



ALL BIRDS BEING CONSIDERED FOR SHOWING MUST BE EXAMINED FOR SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF DISEASE AND/OR PARASITES BEFORE LEAVING THE OWNERS PROPERTY.

- Any bird being considered for show should display an alert and proper balanced stance, be fully feathered, have clear eyes with equal pupils, clear nostrils, clear ears, clean vent area, and be free of all mites and/or lice.
- Birds that are generally unthrifty, thin, and/or lame, have discharge from eyes, nostrils, ears, or vent, have misshapen pupils, have open lesions, or have the presence of mites and/or lice, should not be brought into a showroom. **EVER**
